

Southern Sierra MotoTrials Club COVID-19 Mitigation Plan

Introduction

Motorcycle Observed Trials is inherently a “socially distant” sport. In the Trials sections, only one rider is allowed at a time. Around the loop connecting the trials sections, riders typically ride alone or in small groups separated by relatively large distances. A few minor modifications to Trials’ norms will make the sport compatible with guidelines from government bodies for minimizing the chances for transmission of the COVID- 19 virus.

Mitigation Plan

1. Online, and on all event marketing, it will be advised that if anyone has been COVID exposed within the last 14 days, or someone who is currently running a fever, or sick, they must stay home.
2. Social distancing guidelines will be followed by:
 - a. Event participants. Event participants will maintain six feet of distance between each other while competing.
 - b. All event goers (spectators, workers, participants) will maintain a minimum of six feet of distance and **appropriately wear face masks/coverings when outside their camp (camp defined as a gathering of household members).
 - c. All event workers will appropriately wear face masks/coverings and gloves when performing event duties.
4. The sign-up area will not be a place to hang-out and will be limited to essential business only. Workers and participants will be required to adhere to the policies outlined in item 2.
5. All attempts will be made to reduce contact between riders and workers. In places where contact could occur, sanitary wipes, and hand sanitizer will be provided.
6. Porta Potties will be supplied with hand sanitizer.
7. Riders, workers, etc., will be notified online and on all marketing documents that if they are camping, that camps need to be socially distanced to avoid interaction (less than 6 ft) with non-household members.
8. All commonly touched items will be cleaned regularly, especially at sign up. Pens will be single use. Participants will be encouraged to bring their own pen.

**Appropriate face mask wear must include covering the nose and mouth.
